Program Overview

The Community Opioid Addiction Program at Addiction Services of Thames Valley offers both **direct client services** (counselling and case management) and **community education** to achieve the following goals:

- Improve the health and social outcomes and quality of life for people living with opioid addictions
- Increase the availability and appropriateness of services targeted to people with opioid addictions, with a priority on youth, people living with HIV/AIDS or HEP C, and women who are pregnant and/or parenting
- Increase access to opioid addiction treatment and primary health care
- Improve linkages between community programs
- Reduce involvement with criminal justice system

As a harm-reduction agency, Addiction Services of Thames Valley supports individuals with a wide range of goals, including abstinence, moderation and/or harm reduction and assists individuals in any stage of change.

COAP offers direct services for individuals looking to make changes in their opioid use and/or opioid substitution therapy by providing **assessment, treatment planning, counselling, and case management** services.

To reduce barriers to service, COAP staff members try their best to meet clients in community spaces that are safe and comfortable for that individual.

Community Education Services

COAP also provides education for community members and service providers in effort to increase awareness and knowledge about opioid addiction and opioid substitution therapies. COAP is available for presentations and educational events, as well as consultation.
